General information

Organizational Details

- Location: Kapitelplatz in the City of Salzburg, including urban areas and surrounding city hills

Competition Rules

The event is based on the regulations of the Austrian Athletics Federation (ÖLV) and the Austrian Trail Running Association (ATRA). The relevant rules and regulations can be viewed on the [ÖLV website](#) and the [ATRA website](#).

Road Traffic Regulations

Participants must follow the instructions of traffic authorities (police, race officials, and course marshals) and comply with the Austrian Road Traffic Regulations (StVO 1960). The use of sidewalks and attention to pedestrian crossings is mandatory, as the course is not completely closed to public traffic.

Anti-Doping

The anti-doping regulations of the International Association of Athletics Federations (IAAF), the ÖLV, the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA), the National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA), as well as the anti-doping provisions of the Federal Sports Promotion Act (BSFG) and their implementation, are fully applicable. The respective regulations can be viewed on the relevant organizations' websites.

Athletes participating in the events are required to familiarize themselves with the rules and procedures regarding testing, sanctions, and appeals.

Athletes who have been convicted of doping may be refused entry by the organizer even after their suspension period has expired. Furthermore, the organizer reserves the right, for important reasons, to disqualify athletes in consultation with the competition jury. Participants disqualified for obvious cheating may be banned from starting in future years.

Registration

Eligibility

Participants must be aware of the sporting challenge and be appropriately prepared, trained, and equipped.

All women and men born in 2014 or earlier are eligible to participate. For the Festung Trail, Gaisberg Trail, and Gaisberg Race, eligibility begins with those born in 2010 or earlier. Children born between 2015 and 2024 are eligible for the Kids Trail. Children younger than the 2024 age group may start in the “Windel Kids” category if accompanied by their parents. The stated age group years must be strictly observed.

Registration

Registration is carried out via online registration through the organizer’s registration portal. During online registration, the liability waiver must be accepted. By accepting the competition terms and conditions during the online registration process, participants fully agree to the event regulations (announcement, rules, and participation conditions) in their latest valid version.

The right to a starting place becomes valid only after payment has been received through the organizer’s registration portal, provided that starting slots are still





available. The list of participants can be viewed via the organizer’s registration portal.

Entry Fees

All prices include the applicable value-added tax (VAT). Any transaction fees for online payment must be covered by the participant.

The entry fee includes services such as comprehensive race organization, refreshments during and after the competition, medical and rescue services, athlete gifts, and much more.

The online registration is open until 1 hour before the respective start time. On-site registration at the race office is not possible.

Services

All participants benefit from comprehensive race organization, supply of drinks and food along the course and in the finish area, course security, rescue and medical services, and full timekeeping including results lists.

After the event, personalized online certificates are available via the timekeeper’s results website. Every participant receives a finisher medal. Participants in the combined classification receive one finisher medal per contest.

The starter package includes a starter gift as well as numerous additional items and gifts from our sponsors and partners.

Participants in the Festungstrail receive a voucher at the finish (at the fortress) for a free downhill ride on the fortress funicular if needed.





For spectators, entry to Hohensalzburg Fortress is free during the Festungstrail.

For all participants in the Gaisbergtrail and Gaisberggrace, a shuttle service is provided, both for transporting clothing to the Gaisberg summit and for transporting participants from the Gaisberg summit back to the city center.

Cancellation or transfer up to 1 week before the event

We recommend purchasing cancellation insurance during registration. In the case of written cancellation (no reason required) up to 1 week before the event, the entry fee will be refunded minus a €15 processing fee. For transfer to the following year, a €15 processing fee will be retained.

Changes to participant data or transfers to another person are free of charge if carried out by the participant via their login.

A downgrade to another event is possible without a processing fee if done via participant login; however, the difference in entry fee will not be refunded. An upgrade to another event is possible upon payment of the price difference plus a €15 processing fee.

Cancellation or transfer during race week

Cancellations or transfers to the following year are no longer possible. Transfers to another person are possible for a €15 processing fee.

Changes to participant data can be made via participant login.

Transfer to another contest is possible for a €10 processing fee. In case of a downgrade, no refund of the difference will be made; in case of an upgrade, the price difference must also be paid.

Starting place vouchers

Completed registrations cannot be offset or refunded using a starting place voucher received at a later date (e.g., from a raffle).

Starting place vouchers can only be redeemed online and cannot be used for late on-site registrations at the race office.

Event cancellation

If the event cannot be held for any reason, the organizer may cancel the event at any time. In this case, the organizer reserves three options for handling existing registrations:

- Transfer to the following year
- Refund of the entry fee
- Donation / solidarity contribution



In the official communication from the organizer, participants will be given a deadline to indicate their preference. If no response is received within this period, the entry fee will be retained as a donation/solidarity contribution.

Retained fees cover administrative costs for processing (administration, bank charges, postage) as well as already incurred costs for organizing the event (organization, registration, marketing, etc.).

Bib number pickup

Race materials for all participants can be collected at the race office at the following times:

 - o Kidstrail until 13:30
 - o Trail Amadeus and Festungstrail until 15:45
 - o Panoramatrail until 15:55
 - o Gaisbergtrail and Gaisberggrace until 18:00
- **Sunday, 25 October 2026, from 08:00**
 - o Gaisbergtrail until 09:00
 - o Gaisberggrace until 09:20

Participant limits

To ensure event quality and avoid excessive strain on the courses, maximum participant numbers are set:

- Nightrun (incl. Trail Marathon) – 600 participants
- Panorama Trail – 250 participants
- Festung Trail (incl. Trail Marathon & Trail Amadeus) – 520 participants
- Gaisberg Trail (incl. Trail Marathon & Trail Amadeus) – 600 participants
- Gaisberg Race – 110 participants
- Kids Trail – 250 participants
- Trail Amadeus – 60 participants
- Trail Marathon – 180 participants

Waiting list

If an event reaches its participant limit, registration for the waiting list is possible. Starting places will be allocated according to waiting list order.

Liability Waiver and Limitation of Liability

In cases of force majeure, official orders, or safety reasons, the organizer is entitled to make changes to the event or cancel it. In such cases, no claims for damages may be made against the organizer. Entry fees will not be refunded.



The organizer, its legal representatives, and agents are liable only in cases of intent or gross negligence. The organizer assumes no liability for health risks of participants related to participation in the event. The organizer also assumes no liability for items kept free of charge.

Individual ranking

The individual events are scored separately by gender and age group. In addition, there is an overall classification per gender.

Combined rankings

For the combination events (sum of individual times), there are rankings by age group and gender, as well as an overall classification per gender. Participants in the Trail Amadeus are not included in the individual event rankings.





For the Trail Marathon, the times from the Nightrun, Festung Trail, and Gaisberg Trail are added together. For the Trail Amadeus, the times from the Festung Trail and Gaisberg Trail are added together.

The top 20 starters of the Trail Amadeus who are placed within a maximum of 15 minutes behind the respective winning time in the Festung Trail will compete in the Gaisbergtrail as a pursuit race. Starting with the first woman and first man, all subsequent participants will start with the time gap to the athlete placed immediately ahead of them from the Festungtrail.

After 15 minutes, the start will take place for all remaining runners (women and men) of the Trail Amadeus, as well as for all runners of the Gaisbergtrail and the Gaisberggrace.

Prizes

In all events, trophy prizes will be awarded only to the first-place finishers in each age group and to places 1–3 of the overall classification per gender.

Exceptions apply to the Kids Trail and Rookies, where trophy prizes are awarded to places 1–3.

Competition rules

Time Table

The actual time table can be found [online](#).

Time keeping

Timekeeping is carried out using the organizer's official timing system. Personal timing devices are not permitted. The timing chip must be worn during the competition as instructed by the organizer. The chip is a bib transponder attached to the back of the race number. No time will be recorded without this system. Returning the race number with the timing chip is not required.

Time limits

Festungstrail time checkpoints:

- End of lap 1 passage at Kapitelplatz: 17:20
- End of lap 2 passage at Kapitelplatz: 18:15
- Finish at the fortress: 18:30

If the time limit at Kapitelplatz is not met, the participant must hand in their bib number and will be classified in the Panorama Trail.

Gaisberg Trail time checkpoints:

- Gaisberg summit: 13:00
- Aigen campsite (after downhill section): 14:00
- Finish at Kapitelplatz: 14:45

Gaisberg Race time checkpoint:

- Gaisberg summit: 13:00

If the time limit at the Gaisberg summit is not met, the participant must hand in their bib number and withdraw from the race.

Refreshment

The organizer provides sufficient aid stations along the entire course. Details can be found in the event information on the website (kilometers and aid stations). After the race, participants will receive food and drinks in the finish area.

All participants are requested to dispose of waste (packaging, bottles, etc.) only at aid stations.

On Sunday, no cups will be provided at aid stations — participants must carry their own drinking container.



Parking

All participants can park at the Contipark Altstadtgarage (Hildmannplatz 1), just a few minutes' walk from the race office and start at Kapitelplatz, at a reduced rate:

- €4.40 for 4 hours
- €6.60 for 8 hours

Parking tickets must be validated at the race office.

Sanitary facilities

At Kapitelplatz there are portable toilets as well as public restrooms. Additional toilets are available at the Jahn Gymnasium. There are no toilets along the course. Showers and changing rooms are available at the Jahn Gymnasium. The route from Kapitelplatz to the gym is signposted.

Clothing transport & storage

A supervised tent is available at the event area as a clothing storage facility for all participants. The organizer assumes no liability for stored items.

Participants in the Gaisberg race (and Gaisbergtrail participants in case of bad weather) can have clothing transported to the Gaisberg summit. Clothing bags must be clearly labeled with the bib number (waterproof marker) and handed in directly at Kapitelplatz at the clothing transport vehicle.

Shuttle service

A shuttle service for participants and spectators is available on Sunday:

- 10:00 — Bus stop Rudolfskai → Gaisberg summit
- 11:45 — Bus stop Gaisberg summit → Rudolfskai
- 13:15 — Bus stop Gaisberg summit → Rudolfskai

Award Ceremonies

All award ceremonies take place on the stage at Kapitelplatz.

Medical & rescue services

Sufficient rescue stations are positioned along the entire course. In case of emergency, dial 144 and refer to the event.

Photoservice

A photo service is provided for all participants by Sportshot. Personal race photos will be available a few days after the event.
